The selected recipient(s) may be eligible to receive reimbursements up to 100% of the total cost of their approved training course, pending the successful completion of that course.

The following are the criteria for applicants:

- Currently employed by STAC Member company
- Canadian resident
- Self-identify as female
- Applicants must be pursuing advanced education to promote career growth within the industry
 - Examples (project management, safety, train the trainer, programming, leadership, finance, etc.)
- Have completed at least two years of employment within the industry
- Candidate to submit paragraph documenting their current role within the company and how the bursary would be used to advance their career growth within the industry.

- For any courses that have already been completed and paid for, these must be identified on the form and to be eligible for reimbursement they must have been/be completed by December 31, 2023
- Proof of payment is required in order to receive reimbursement – payment must have been a personal expense
- Proof of completion is required that clearly demonstrates that the bursary recipient has completed the course for which they applied. Additional verification may be required.
