




Women of STAC Mentorship Program





Overview




The program model includes individual mentorship pairings as well as activities in a group setting, with an overarching goal of offering guidance, support, and personal & professional development to women in the telecommunications industry.

The Program includes:

- Mentor & group guided and supported activities
- One-on-one and group meetings
- Special guest speakers
- Opportunity to attend the Annual STAC Conference
- A wide variety of learning and networking opportunities








Mentorship Pairings




- Each mentee will be matched with a mentor for the duration of the program.
- Within the pairings the mentor will guide the mentee through specific goals and objectives over the duration of the program (or as otherwise decided within each individual pairing).



The mentee and mentor both agree to check-ins with each other and the program organizers to track progress.










- Follows an open and inclusive program where mentees are mentored in a group setting.
- This will include group meetings with presentations by guest speakers or other mentors in the program that will cover specific topics of interest to the group.
- With the group component, mentees will be encourages to develop professional relationships within the group and broaden their network.
- Provides an opportunity to host high-level leaders and industry representatives to speak and offer career advice, stories and experiences.
- Group meetings would occur once a month throughout the duration of the program.










Each mentee and mentor will be provided with a pass to the virtual STAC 2022 Conference & Exhibition where they will be given a chance to join educational sessions as well as various virtual networking opportunities with those in the program and the STAC community more broadly.














- The program start date will be February 28, 2022 and that will be the first group meeting.
- This six month program will run until the end of August 2022.
- During this time there will be a group meeting each month and a one-on-one meeting within each pairing, unless otherwise determined by the individual pairings.
- Halfway through the program each mentor and mentee will be asked to complete a check-in form to track their progress within their pairings and the group meetings.
- Following the close of the program each mentor and mentee will be asked to complete a final evaluation that will cover their experiences with the program as a whole.








- The level of engagement and active involvement of participants is expected to directly influence the outcome, overall experience and success of the program.
- Each mentor and mentee will be asked to complete and sign a participant commitment form.
- Mentors and mentees must be willing to commit to 6 group meetings and 6 one-on-one meetings, approximately 1-2 hours per month,
 over a period of six months during the program.
 - One-on-one meetings can be flexible and determined within each pairing at the start of the program.


