

Terms of STAC

Annual Certification 2021/2022



STAC Member: The STAC Member is an Associate of the Canadian Wireless Telecommunications Association (CWTA), and the initial application requires approval from the CWTA Board of Directors. STAC Membership benefits encompass STAC Committee activities and projects, exclusively.

The Applicant: Defined as the company applying, and/or renewing their Associate status with CWTA, as a STAC Member. The Applicant holds the membership and is listed as the Associate company on the STAC Membership directory. The Applicant as listed on the Annual Certification Form, (i.e., “Company”) is the official applicant of record.

The Primary Contact: Defined as the individual responsible and accountable for all terms of membership and all information as reported on the Annual Certification Form. The Primary Contact also ensures accuracy with respect to the data reported and used in calculation of the total fee payable. The Primary Contact coordinates with other representatives within its company to participate in STAC activities as relevant.

The Applicant is a Supplier: If the principal focus of the company is to manufacture, distribute, sell or develop products such as safety equipment, telecommunications equipment, tools and/or gear for use by people/companies who provide services or work on telecommunications infrastructure, then the Applicant may calculate their annual fees based on supplier rate outlined in the Fee Schedule. A Supplier Applicant can extend its membership benefits to a subsidiary company(ies) who are also defined as suppliers and reported on the Annual Certification Form.

The Applicant and its Subsidiary companies

Membership benefits *can be extended* to the Applicant **AND** its subsidiaries, but only if:

- Subsidiaries are reported on the Annual Certification Form
- Employees of subsidiaries are included in the total employee count reported in correlation with the fee schedule and corresponding total amount payable by the Applicant
- There is any combination of supplier and non-supplier companies as either Applicant or subsidiary(ies), then the calculation of fees is based on the total employee count reported in correlation with the fee schedule and corresponding total amount payable by the Applicant
- Note: The Applicant is considered the “member”

If the Applicant and its subsidiaries each wish to hold a separate and distinct membership, then:

- In addition to the Applicant, each subsidiary must also complete a completed Annual Certification Form, which must be submitted for approval of the CWTA Board of Directors.
- Once approved, separate renewals must be completed and submitted for each subsidiary annually.
- Note: Each separate and distinct Applicant in the above-described scenario is a “member”

Use of Information

Use of Primary Contact information is reciprocal in nature, such that in all cases where consent is provided, the information gathered will form a STAC Primary Contact Distribution List. Access to the Primary Contact Distribution List will be restricted to STAC Primary Contacts who have also consented to share their information. Providing consent occurs by way of check marking the appropriate box as indicated on Page 1 of the Annual Certification Form. Those who do not consent to sharing of Primary Contact information will not have access to the STAC Primary Contact Distribution List.

STAC Primary Contact Distribution List: Intended use for direct communications between Primary Contact representatives from STAC member companies. The list serves to provide a first point of contact for each consenting STAC member company. Where consent is provided, the sharing of the STAC Primary Contact Distribution List is not intended for any form of marketing, mass emails and/or commercial purposes.
